



What you need to know:

- Fun Clubs run for a <u>whole</u> term. A new form must be completed and signed for each new term.
- Clubs start from Tuesday 17th September 2019
- Clubs finish for half term on Thursday 24th October 2019
- Clubs will recommence on Tuesday 5th November until Thursday 19th
 December 2019
- This totals 13 weeks
- They run from 3.10 until 5pm.
- Pupils will sign up for an evening and have the chance to sample all the different activities we have to offer. There will be a 3 or 4 week rotation of activities so everyone gets a variety. You will be sent a timetable of their activities so they (and you) know what they will be doing each week.

- You will get a confirmation slip saying that you have a place

Please Note:

Osborne Fun Clubs are an ideal opportunity for our pupils to socialise and have fun after school for two hours.

TUESDAY:

- Osborne Fun Clubs are self-funded; 1:1 staffing is charged for as extra
- Osborne Fun Clubs start on the first week back after a new term and the first week back after a half term. The only exception being Autumn Term.
- Forms cannot be processed and places allocated without a parent/guardians signature
- No refunds are given if you have a place in a club and you do not attend for whatever reason
- In the event of not getting a place or not wanting to choose an alternative activity, parents will be contacted to see if a refund is needed or if a credit will be carried over to the next term. No preferences are given to those holding credit
- Any credits which remain outstanding at the end of the school year will be refunded before the last day of the Summer Term
- Osborne School is now accepting childcare vouchers as payments for clubs. Please contact the school if you have any queries
- All pupils <u>must</u> be signed out by a parent or carer after club.
- If there are any changes to regular collection arrangements or a pupil will not be staying for clubs one evening please call the school or write in the home/school diary. Texts to the out of hours mobile (number on confirmation forms) will also be acceptable.
