



Curriculum Overview

Subject: Humanities

Key Stage 3: “Where are We Going and Where Do We Come From?”

Geography:

In Key Stage 3 we cover a diverse range of human and physical topics, including coasts, the geography of fashion festivals, tectonics and personal geographies.

History:

In Key Stage 3 we aim to give an overview of past lives and events from The Norman Conquest to the present day. Students investigate the past through a series of topics and activities and develop key historical skills. Students extend their learning beyond the classroom through trips, visitors to the school and whole day activities through a Curriculum Theme Day.

MFL:

Students study French for half termly units throughout key stage 3. We encourage modern language study for all, recognising the communication skills of both language learning and the awareness of other cultures as important contributions to Global Citizenship.

Key Stage 4: “The World Around Us” (Geography and History)

We aim to enthuse students with a lifelong interest of the world around us and to ensure that they have a better understanding of the present world as a result.

Students are able to continue to study the World Around US as an option, where aspects of geography and history are looked at in greater detail which enables students to study a broader variety of topics and eras whilst also developing their skills in all aspects of historical and geographical study.
