## Times of Day

Age 5 to 7 ★



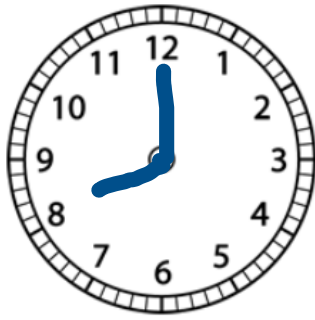
Here are five pictures showing something happening at different times of the day.

Have a good look at each one. What do you see in the picture? What is happening? Could you describe it to someone else?

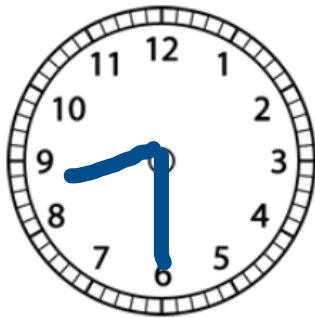
You could use these pictures in different ways. For example:

1. You could put them into an order in which you think they might happen through a day.
2. You could suggest what time these things happen in your day.
3. You could see how many hours might pass between pairs of pictures you have chosen.
4. You could draw another picture that might 'fit' between two of the pictures.
5. You will have your own ideas too...

**Worked example:**



*I get out of bed at 8 o'clock in the morning.*



*At half past 8 I have my breakfast after I have got dressed.*

**Variation**

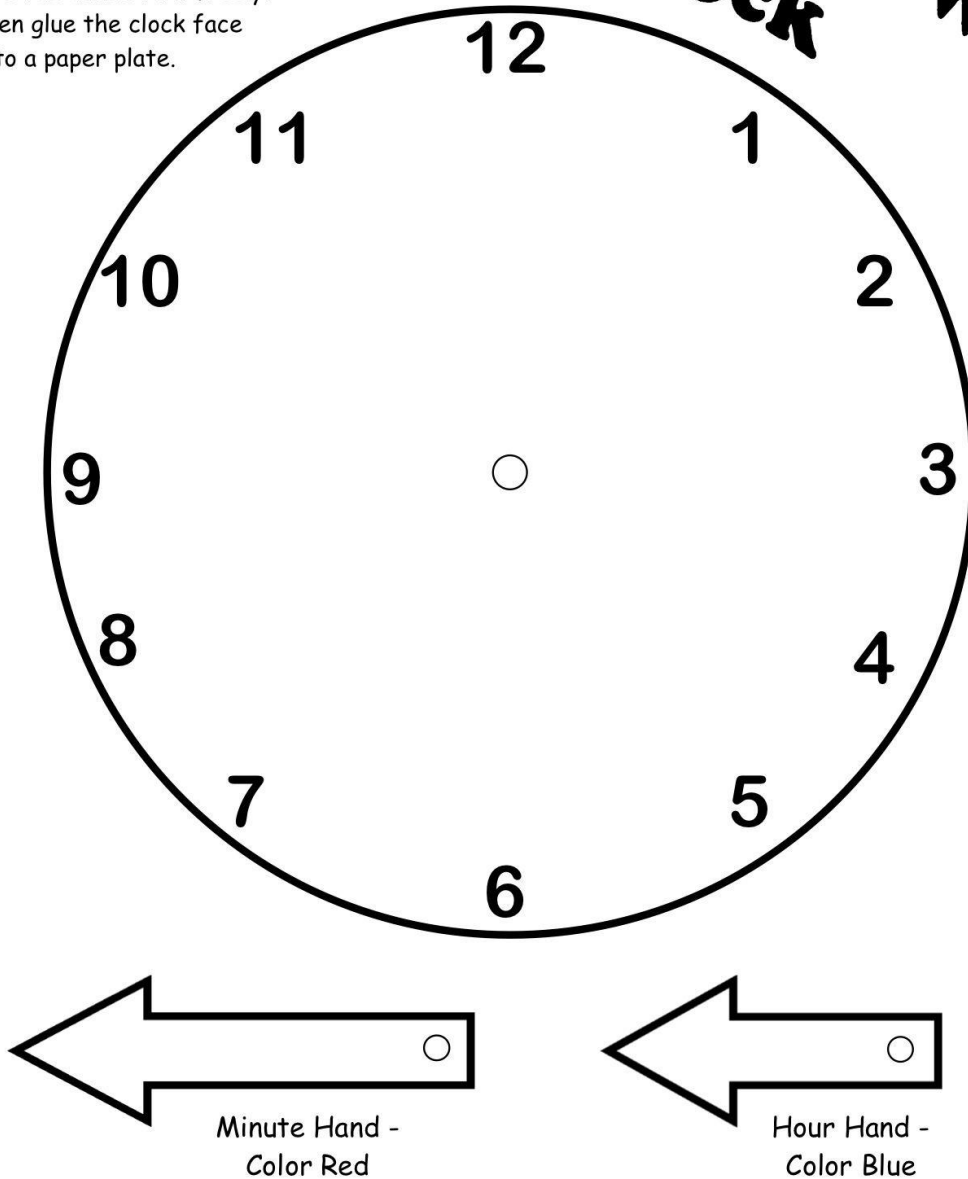
**Challenge**

Make your own moving clockface with a paper plate or circle of cardboard. Make hands out of thick card and use a split pin or wool tied at the back to make your own clock. Practise making different times and reading them. You could use the template below:

**Directions:**

Color the hands of the clock. Cut out the hands and clock face. Use a paper fastener to attach the hands to the face. Make sure the hands turn freely. Then glue the clock face onto a paper plate.
