What is outreach?

Osborne School Outreach Service provides local mainstream secondary schools with specialist support to help them to meet the needs of their pupils with SEND. The service is free of charge to Hampshire maintained schools. Please contact the Outreach Team for further information about costs if you are an academy.

What support do we provide?

- Consultation with SENCOs and other key staff to offer advice and strategies
- Observation of pupils to inform future support
- Support with curriculum differentiation
- Support in setting up the learning environment
- Transition work
- Inreach visits for staff
- INSET and training in a range of areas



Who are the outreach team?

Stewart Lang – Stewart has worked in mainstream and special schools. He is Assistant Head at Osborne School, where he runs the Oskings provision at Kings School.

Carson Elday – Carson has worked in Hampshire special schools for the past 24 years. As well as working as part of the outreach team he is a classroom teacher. He has a particular interest in Autism.
